At FSR he brings his knowledge of packing, outfitting, hunting, fishing, horticulture and a positive attitude. Cody is a wonderful asset to all our patrons and to the visions and goals of FlySpur Ranch.



Hopefully by now, you've been able to ride out from our new auxiliary property, Rock Springs Ranch. It is located just 2 1/2 short miles from us, down Bailey/Tumalo Reservoir Rd. There are miles of stunning trails, splendid water crossings and mountain views.

Therese & Kevin worked for over a year to qualify for a Special Recreational Use Permit (SRP) with the Bureau of Land Management (BLM). An SRP is required for any commercial use on the BLM, and similar permits are required for other public and private tracts and lands in and around Bend.

FSR and HSW/RSR are currently the **only** permit holders in the Tumalo area licensed by the Oregon State Marine Board to take public guided trips (including horseback, hiking, jogging and mountain biking), and are the **only** permit holders for these portions of the BLM for horseback riding.

This is not only a very special privilege & right that very few outfitters obtain, but also an important obligation and responsibility. Not only does FlySpur pay a portion of its income to the BLM each year, it also carries the mantle of trail maintenance, land stewardship,

environmental impact practices, leave-no-trace policy and education that Rock Springs Guest Ranch initially established and continued to maintain for over a half a century here in the beautiful High Desert!

Rider Qualification Levels

ALL TRAIL RIDING MUST BE ACCOMPANIED BY A STATE-CERTIFIED GUIDE.

Level 1 = Beginner/Novice. Ride only Level 1 horses under instruction at Ranch.

Level 2 = Learned. Ride & practice Level 1 & 2 horses Ranch & Trail; Level 3 horses under instruction at Ranch.

Level 3 = Intermediate/Skilled. Level 1, 2 & 3 horses Ranch & Trail; Level 4 under instruction at Ranch.

Level 4 = Advanced. Ride all Level 1, 2, 3 & 4 horses at Ranch and on trails.

Level 5 = Guide/Wrangler. State-Certified Guide for FlySpur Ranch. Ride all horses, guide others.
